FLEUR
SWEATER

Multicolored sweater
Instruction: Åsa Christiansen

Størrelse:
(XXS) XS (S) M (L) XL (XXL)

Measurements:

Bust: (82) 86 (94) 102 (111) 120 (126) cm

Length: approx (53) 54 (55) 56 (57) 58 (59) cm

Sleeve length: 50 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

BØRSTET ALPAKKA (96 % alpaca, 4 % nylon, 50 g = 110 m)

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

Yarn required:

BØRSTET ALPAKKA

Powder pink #4602: (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 (4) balls

Lt.yellow #2112: (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 (4) balls

Burnt sugar #2543: 1 ball all sizes

Lt.blue-grey #6220: 1 ball all sizes

TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Golden brown #2755: (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 (5) balls

Burnt sugar #2543: (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 (5) balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 5.5 mm and 6 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

13 sts St-st with triple yarn (1 strand BØRSTET ALPAKKA and 2 strands TYNN SILK MOHAIR) and 6 mm ndls = 10 cm

Work sweater with triple yarn, 1 strand BØRSTET ALPAKKA and 2 strands TYNN SILK MOHAIR. The color for BØRSTET ALPAKKA is changed for the different sections.

Color 1:

1 strand lt.blue-grey BØRSTET ALPAKKA, 1 strand burnt sugar TYNN SILK MOHAIR, and 1 strand golden brown TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Color 2:

1 strand lt.yellow BØRSTET ALPAKKA, 1 strand burnt sugar TYNN SILK MOHAIR, and 1 strand golden brown TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Color 3:

1 strand powder pink BØRSTET ALPAKKA, 1 strand burnt sugar TYNN SILK MOHAIR, and 1 strand golden brown TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Color 4:

1 strand burnt sugar BØRSTET ALPAKKA, 1 strand burnt sugar TYNN SILK MOHAIR, and 1 strand golden brown TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Back and front:

With **color 1** and 5.5 mm circular ndl cast on (106) 112 (122) 132 (144) 156 (164) sts. Join and work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 6 mm circular ndl, **color 3** and cont St-st until garment meas approx 34 cm, all sizes.

Insert marker at each side with (53) 56 (61) 66 (72) 78 (82) sts for each part.

Cast off (2) 2 (4) 4 (4) 6 (6) sts at each side for armholes (= (1) 1 (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) sts at each side of markers), and work each part separately.

Edge st: k every row.**Back:**

= (51) 54 (57) 62 (68) 72 (76) sts.

Cont St-st back and forth, **at the same time** dec for raglan from RS as follows: 1 edge st, k2tog, work until 3 sts rem, k2tog tbl, 1 edge st.

Rep raglan dec on alt rows (14) 15 (16) 17 (18) 19 (20) times = (23) 24 (25) 28 (32) 34 (36) sts.

Transfer the (19) 20 (21) 22 (24) 26 (28) middle sts for neck to spare ndl, and work each side separately.

Work (4) 4 (3) 3 (3) 2 (2) rows without cast off.

Cast off (2) 2 (2) 3 (4) 4 (4) shoulder sts.

Front:

= (51) 54 (57) 62 (68) 72 (76) sts.

Work and dec for raglan in the same manner as the back a total of (7) 8 (9) 10 (11) 12 (13) times = (37) 38 (39) 42 (46) 48 (50) sts.

Transfer the (9) 10 (11) 12 (14) 16 (18) middle front sts for neck to spare ndl, and work each side separately.

Cast off at neck on alt rows 1 st 5 times, **at the same time** cont raglan dec 7 times more. Cont straight after cast off for neck is finished.

Cont until front meas the same as the back.

Cast off (2) 2 (2) 3 (4) 4 (4) shoulder sts.

Right sleeve:

With **color 3** and 5.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (24) 26 (26) 28 (28) 30 (30) sts. Join and work 12 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 6 mm double pointed ndls and **color 2**, **at the same time** inc 1 st in every st on rnd = (48) 52 (52) 56 (56) 60 (60) sts.

Insert marker between first and last st on rnd.

Cont St-st until sleeve meas 20 cm.

Cast off 1 st at each side of marker as follows: k2tog after marker and k2tog tbl before marker.

Rep dec every (5½) 4½ (5½) 4½ (5½) 4½ (5½) cm until (38) 40 (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) sts.

Cont until sleeve meas 50 cm, or suitable length

Cast off (2) 2 (4) 4 (4) 6 (6) middle underarm sts (= (1) 1 (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) sts at each side of marker), and cont sleeve cap back and forth.

From RS dec for raglan as follows: 1 edge st, k2tog, work until 3 sts rem, k2tog tbl, 1 edge st.

Rep dec on alt rows (14) 15 (16) 17 (18) 19 (20) times = (8) 8 (6) 6 (6) 4 (4) sts.

Cast off.

Left sleeve:

Work in the same manner as right sleeve but work ribbing in **color 4**, and change to **color 2** for rem sleeve.

Finishing:

Sew shoulder sts

Sew sleeves on.

Neck band:

Transfer sts from spare ndls and at the same time knit up sts with **color 4** and small 5.5 mm circular ndl over the cast off sts at neck edge to approx (54) 56 (58) 60 (64) 66 (68) sts on ndl. Number of sts a multiple of 4

Work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold ribbing and sew loosely on WS.
