GUSTAV SWEATER

Sweater in rib-pattern Instruction: Liv Stangeland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6-8) 10 (12) yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (66) 71 (77) 83 (89) cm Length: approx (38) 42 (46-50) 54

(54) cm

Sleeve length: (25) 28 (32-35) 38 (40)

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:

KOS (62 % baby alpaca, 9 % wool, 29 % nylon, 50 g = 150 m)

Yarn required:

Lt,yellowish brown #2533: (4) 4 (5-6) 7 (8) balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 4 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

14 sts and 44 rows rib-pattern and 4 mm ndls = 10 x10 cm

Rib-pattern worked in rnds:

Rnd 1: *p tog yo and 1 st, 1 yo, sl 1 p-wise*, rep from *-* in the rnd.
Rnd 2: *1 yo, sl 1 p-wise, k tog yo and 1 st*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Rib-pattern worked back and forth:

Row 1: (WS) *k tog yo and 1 st, 1 yo, sl 1 p-wise*, rep from *-*.

Row 2: work as row 1, and ensure k and p sts to cont in the same order.

Always dec on rnd 2 of rib-pattern Dec to the left:

SI yo behind stitch and turn the stitch, k3tog tbl (= the turned st, 1 p st, 1 k st and yo).

Dec to the right: k3tog (= 1 k st and yo, 1 p st, 1 k st and yo)

NOTE:

Change to new ball of yarn at side of garment.

Back and front:

With 4 mm circular ndl cast on (114) 124 (134) 144 (154) sts. Join and work (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm ribbing p1, k1 in rnds, **while** dec evenly spaced (22) 24 (26) 28 (30) sts on last rnd as follows: *Work 7 st, k3tog*, rep from *-*, end with 4 sts = (92) 100 (108) 116 (124) sts on rnd.

Insert marker around 1 p st at each side with (45) 49 (53) 57 (61) sts between markers.

Cont **rib-pattern** in rnds and beg as follows: *1 yo, sl 1 p-wise, k1*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Cont **rib-pattern** until work meas (26) 29 (31-35) 38 (37) cm

End with rnd 2 of rib-pattern and cast off 3 sts at each side for armholes (= marked st + 1 st at each side).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 4 mm double pointed ndls cast on (30) 32 (34) 36 (36) sts. Join and work (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds, **while** dec 6 sts evenly spaced on last rnd as follows: *Work 7 sts ribbing, k3tog*, rep from *-*, end with (0) 2 (4) 6 (6) sts ribbing = (24) 26 (28) 30 (30) sts on rnd.

Insert marker around first st of rnd.

Cont **rib-pattern** in rnds and beg as follows: work *1 yo, sl 1 p-wise, k1*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Cont **rib-pattern** until sleeve meas (6) 7 (6) 7 (6) cm.

Always inc on rnd 1 in **rib-pattern**. Inc 1 st at each side of marker (inc = pick up yarn between 2 sts and p/k tbl this new st).

Beg inc with p tbl, and inc alternately k tbl, p tbl.

NOTE: Adjust sts to rib-pattern during work.

Rep inc every (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ (4) cm a total of (5) 5 (7) 7 (9) times = (34) 36 (42) 44 (48) sts.

Cont util sleeve meas approx (25) 28 (32-35) 38 (40) cm, or suitable length End with rnd 2 of **rib-pattern** and cast off 3 sts at middle underarm (= marked st + 1 st at each side).

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

Raglan

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve

above each armhole cast-off = (148) 160 (180) 192 (208) sts.

Insert marker around 3 sts in from each junction on sts at back and sts at front (= p1, k1, p1).

Rnd beg at right side on the back.

Work 5 rnds rib-pattern.

Cast off for raglan at each marker as follows:

Work marked sts (p1, k1, p1 in rib-pattern), dec to the right, work rib-pattern until 3 sts rem before next marker, dec to the left, rep from *-* in the rnd = 16 sts dec. Rep dec every 8th rnd a total of (5) 5 (6) 7 (8) times = (68) 80 (84) 80 (80) sts.

Sizes 4 (6-8) yrs:

Rep dec every 4th rnd, but over sleeve sts only once = 8 sts dec and 72 (76) sts rem.

All sizes:

Transfer the (9) 9 (9) 13 (13) middle front sts for neck to spare ndl.

Cont to end of rnd, cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Work **rib-pattern** back and forth, and cont to cast off 1 st at beg of every row at each side of neck, **at the same time** dec for raglan every 4th row but twice more over sleeve sts only. Cast off rem sts.

Finishing:

Sew underarm holes.

With small 4 mm circular ndl knit up sts at neck edge to approx (64) 66 (68) 70 (72) sts.

Work (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise. Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts
