STRIPED
SWEATER*Raglan sweater w/stripes*
*Instruction: Sandnes Garn***Sizes:**

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (64) 67 (71) 76 (80) 84 cm

Length: approx (36) 40 (45) 48 (52) 54 cm

Sleeve length: (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

Yarn:MERINOULL (100 % merino wool,
50 g = 105 m)

Or

DUO (55 % merino wool, 45 % cotton,
50 g = 124 m)**Alternative yarn:**

PEER GYNT, SMART, ALPAKKA

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

MERINOULL

White #1002: (4) 4 (5) 6 (6) 7 balls

Dk.petrol #7364: (1) 1 (2) 2 (2) 2 balls

Or

DUO

Aks yellow #2124: (3) 3 (4) 5 (6) 6 balls

Curry #2336: (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Stripe pattern:

Work *6 rnds white/aks yellow, 2 rnds dk.petrol/curry*, rep from *-*

Back and front:

With white/aks yellow and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (140) 148 (156) 168 (176) 184 sts. Join and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Insert marker at sides with (70) 74 (78) 84 (88) 92 sts for each part.

Change to 3.5 mm circular ndl and work **stripe pattern** until garment meas (22) 26 (29) 31 (34) 34 cm.

Cast off (6) 6 (6) 6 (8) 8 sts at each side for armholes (= (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:With white/aks yellow and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (32) 36 (36) 40 (40) 44 sts. Join and work (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds, **while** inc evenly spaced (4) 4 (4) 4 (6) 6 sts on last rnd = (36) 40 (40) 44 (46) 50 sts.

Insert marker around first and last st of rnd.

Change to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls and work **stripe pattern, at the same time** inc 1 st at each side of marker when sleeve meas (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 cm. Rep inc every (3) 4 (3) 3½ (3) 3½ cm until (48) 52 (56) 60 (64) 68 sts.

Cont until sleeve meas (26) 30 (33) 36 (39) 40 cm, or suitable length, and with the same stripe as back/front.

Cast off (6) 6 (6) 6 (8) 8 middle underarm sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3.5 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (212) 228 (244) 264 (272) 288 sts.

Insert marker at each junction.

Cont **stripe pattern, at the same time** dec for raglan at each marker as follows: k2tog after each marker, and sl 1 k-wise, k1, pssso before each marker = 8 sts dec.Rep raglan dec on alt rnds, **at the same time** cont with white/aks yellow only after (2) 3 (3) 3 (3) 4 stripes in dk.petrol/curry.

Cont raglan dec until a total of (13) 14 (15) 17 (17) 18 times = (108) 116 (124) 128 (136) 144 sts on rnd.

Cast off the (10) 10 (10) 12 (12) 14 middle front sts for neck and cont to end of rnd. Cut yarn and beg again at

neck. Cont back and forth and dec for raglan on RS rows.

Cast off at neck at beg of every row at each side 2 sts twice for all sizes, then 1 st (2)2(3)3(4)4 times, **at the same time** dec for raglan as before (4) 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 times more.

Cast off rem sts.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Neckband:

With white/aks yellow and small 3 mm circular ndl knit up approx (80) 84 (88) 88 (92) 96 sts at neck. Number of sts a multiple of 4.

Work approx 3 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.
