



WORKED FROM NECK DOWN WITH CABLES ON ROUND YOKE / INSTRUCTION: OLAUG BEATE BJELLAND

SIZES

(XS)S(M)L(XL)XXL-XXXL

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (99) 105 (110) 119 (124) 130 cm Length: (69) 72 (72) 74 (76) 76 cm, or suitable length

Sleeve length: 47 cm, or suitable length All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

DUO (55 % merino wool, 45 % cotton, 50 g = 124 m)

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 q = 212 m)

YARN REQUIRED

DUO

Golden brown #2564: (7) 8 (9) 9 (10) 11 balls TYNN SILK MOHAIR Brown sugar #2543: (3) 4 (4) 4 (5) 5 balls

NOTIONS

8 buttons

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 4 mm and 5.5 mm Small circular 5.5 mm for sleeves Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

16 sts St-st with double yarn (1 strand DUO + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR) and 5.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

21 sts diagram with $5.5 \, \text{mm} \, \text{ndls} = 10 \, \text{cm}$

INC FOR ROUND YOKE WITH INC WORKED IN A MIRROR IMAGE OF EACH OTHER

Inc to the right <u>after</u> 2 p sts as follows: After 2 p sts pick up yarn on previous rnd, transfer this new st k tbl-wise to left ndl and k this st. Inc to the left <u>before</u> 2 p sts as follows: Before 2 sts pick up yarn on previous rnd, transfer st k-wise to left ndl and k tbl this st.

GSR = GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always slide first st p-wise off ndl, lead yarn over right ndl, pull yarn firmly on WS until 2 loops on the ndl.
These 2 loops count as 1 stitch.
For rnds/rows with loops, k loops tog to 1 st.

INFO

Work cardigan from neck down and inc for round yoke. Work back and forth with front band at each side and with 8 buttonholes evenly spaced on right front band. The lower placed at middle of ribbing.

SI first st k-wise on every row, pull yarn firmly before cont further.

YOKE

With 4 mm circular ndl cast on (91) 97 (97) 103 (103) 109 sts.

Work front bands and ribbing as follows: Row 1: (= WS) SI first st k-wise, *p1, k1*, rep from *-* to end of rnd.

 $\underline{\text{Row 2:}}$ SI first st k-wise, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with k2.

Work 3 rows in the same manner.

Work buttonhole on next row as follows (= RS): Work until 5 sts rem, 1 yo, k2tog, work to end of row.

Work 3 rows in the same manner, while dec 1 st on last row as follows:

Work 8 sts (front band), p2tog and cont k on k sts, p on p sts to end of row = (90) 96 (96) 102 (102) 108 sts.

Change to 5.5 mm circular ndl Read next chapter before cont knitting. Rep buttonhole every (8½) 9 (9) 9 (9½) 9½ cm, at the same time work diagram inside 8 front band sts at each side, and inc as shown in diagram = (234) 252 (252) 270 (270) 288 sts. NOTE: Turn on 8th and 9th row with GSR inside 8 front band sts at each side (as explained to avoid front bands to bulge). Rep turning at front bands every 8th and 9th row further in the work.

Remember buttonholes.

When diagram is finished cont St-st over all sts inside front bands until garment meas approx (21) 22 (23) 24 (25) 26 cm, meas from shoulder/highest point with garment placed flat on table.

Divide work as follows:

Work (40) 42 (42) 46 (46) 50 sts (= front), transfer (42) 46 (46) 48 (48) 52 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on (8) 8 (12) 12 (16) 16 new underarm sts, work (70) 76 (76) 82 (82) 84 sts (= the back), transfer (42) 46 (46) 48 (48) 52 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on (8) 8 (12) 12 (16) 16 new underarm sts, work (40) 42 (42) 46 (46) 50 sts (= front).

BACK AND FRONT

= (166) 176 (184) 198 (206) 216 sts. Cont St-st with 5.5 mm circular ndl inside 8 front band sts as before. Remember buttonholes and turnings further until garment meas approx (64) 67 (67) 69 (71) 71 cm, meas from shoulder/highest point and straight down with garment placed flat on table, or 5 cm before suitable length. At the same time inc (11) 11 (13) 13 (15) 15 sts evenly spaced on last row, (no inc over front band sts) = (177) 187 (197) 211 (221) 231 sts.

Change to 4 mm circular ndl and work 5 cm ribbing k1, p1 inside 8 sts as before.

Remember last buttonhole at middle of neck band.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

SIFFVES

Transfer sts for sleeve to small 5.5 mm circular ndl and knit 1 st in each of the new underarm sts = (50) 54 (58) 60 (64) 68 sts. <u>Tips</u>: Pick up yarn between sleeve sts and the new underarm sts at each side, and on first rnd k this new st tog with next st to avoid hole. Insert marker at middle underarm. Work 4 cm St-st.

Cast off 2 sts at middle underarm as follows: k2tog before marker and k2tog tbl after marker. Rep dec every (7) 6 (4½) 4½ (4) 4 cm until (42) 44 (44) 46 (48) 50 sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas 42 cm, or 5 cm before suitable length, while dec 10 sts evenly spaced on last rnd = (32) 34 (34) 36 (38) 40 sts. Change to 4 mm double pointed ndls and work 5 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

FINISHING

Sew in sleeves.
