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# GYDA SWEATER

# SIZES (XS) S (M) L (XL) XXL (XXXL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (88) 96 (102) 108 (116) 124 (130) cm Length: approx (56) 56 (58) 60 (61) 62 (63) cm Sleeve length: 47 cm, or suitable length All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

# YARN

SMART (100 % wool, Superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

# ALTERNATIVE YARN

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MERINOULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

### YARN REQUIRED

Dk.blue melange #6272: (8) 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) balls

Amber yellow #2324: 1 ball all sizes Sea-green melange #7252: 1 ball all sizes Natural melange #2641: 1 ball all sizes Dusty purple #5052: 1 ball all sizes

#### SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3.5 mm and 4 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### TENSION

20 sts x 24 rounds diagram with 4 mm ndls = 10 x 10 cm

#### **BACK AND FRONT**

With dk.blue melange and 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on (176) 192 (204) 216 (232) 248 (260) sts. Join and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 4 mm circular ndl. Insert marker at sides with (88) 96 (102) 108 (116) 124 (130) sts for each part. Cont St-st until garment meas (38) 38 (39) 40 (40) 40 (40) cm. Cast off (8) 8 (8) 8 (8) 10 (10) sts at each side for armholes (= (4) 4 (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

# SLEEVES

With dk.blue melange and 3.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (36) 36 (38) 40 (42) 44

(46) sts. Join and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 4 mm double pointed ndls. Insert marker around first and last st of rnd. Cont St-st and when sleeve meas 7 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc approx every (3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> (3) 3 (3) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> (2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) cm until (58) 60 (64) 68 (70) 76 (80) sts on ndls. Cont until sleeve meas 47 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off (8) 8 (8) 8 (8) 10 (10) middle underarm sts (= marked sts + (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

# ROUND YOKE

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (260) 280 (300) 320 (340) 360 (380) sts. Work (0) 0 (2) 4 (6) 8 (10) rnds St-st. Work <u>diagram</u> and dec as shown in diagram = (104) 106 (108) 110 (112) 114 (116) sts. Leave sts on ndl for neckband.

# FINISHING

Sew underarm openings.

## **ROUND NECK**

Change to small 3.5 mm circular ndl and work 8 cm ribbing in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise. Fold neckband and sew loosely on WS.

#### TURTLENECK

Change to small 3.5 mm circular ndl and work 20 cm ribbing in rnds. Cast off loosely rib-wise. Fold to RS.
