#MOSEJAKKE / NO 3 / INSTRUCTION: LIV STANGELAND KNITTING SKILL LEVEL *** MEDIUM

SIZE

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (65) 68 (75) 77 (84) 89 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 52 cm, or suitable length Sleeve length: (24) 27 (29) 32 (35) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE CARDIGAN

Work garment back and forth from neck down, and inc for round voke.

Work front bands at finish.

YARN

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

Rose tree #4245: (4) 4 (5) 6 (7) 8 balls

NOTIONS

(6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 buttons

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle $\frac{1}{2} \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} \frac{1}{2} \int_$

TENSION

 $27\,sts$ St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm $27\,sts$ and 40 rows pattern with 2.5 mm ndls = 10x10 cm

RIB STITCH (RIB-ST)

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PATTERN WORKED BACK AND FORTH

Row 1: Work p2, *1 rib-st, p2*, rep from *-* to end of

 $\underline{\text{Row 2}}$ Work k2, *p1, k2*, rep from *-* to end of row. Rep row 1 - 2.

INC 1

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch

Edge st: k every row

YOKE

Work garment from neck down.

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on a little loose (91) 97 (103) 109 (115) 121 sts and work 8 rows ribbing back and forth as follows:

(Row 1 = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Inc from WS in this manner:

Work 1 edge st, k1, inc 1, *p1, k1, inc 1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st = (136) 145 (154) 163 (172) 181 sts.

Work pattern inside 1 edge st at each side until work meas $5\,\mathrm{cm}$, last row from RS.

Inc from WS in this manner:

Work 1 edge st, inc 1, k2, *p1, inc 1, k2*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st = (181) 193 (205) 217 (229) 241 sts. Work pattern but with p3 and 1 rib-st until work meas 8 cm, last row from RS.

Inc from WS in this manner:

Work 1 edge st, k3, inc 1, *p1, k3, inc 1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st = (226) 241 (256) 271 (286) 301 sts. Work pattern, but with p4 and 1 rib-st until work meas (11) 11 (11) 12 (13) 14 cm, last row from RS.

Inc from WS in this manner:

Work 1 edge st, inc 1, k4, *p1, inc 1, k4*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st = (271) 289 (307) 325 (343) 361 sts. Work pattern, but with p5 and 1 rib-st until work meas (14) 15 (16) 18 (19) 20 cm.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl, cont St-st and divide work for sleeves, back and front in this manner:

Work (39) 41 (45) 46 (50) 53 sts for front, transfer (58) 62 (64) 70 (72) 76 sts to spare ndl for sleeves, cast on (8) 8 (10) 10 (12) 14 new underarm sts, work (77) 83

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BACK AND FRONT

= (171) 181 (199) 205 (223) 237 sts.

Work St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side until garment meas approx (33) 37 (41) 44 (48) 48 cm, or (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm before suitable length, last row from WS.

Change to 2.5 mm circular ndl and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing as follows:

1 edge st, k1, *p1, k1*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st. Cast off rib-wise.

SLEEVES

Transfer sleeve sts to 3 mm double pointed ndls and knit up 1 st in each of the (8) 8 (10) 10 (12) 14 new underarm sts = (66) 70 (74) 80 (84) 90 sts.

Insert marker at middle underarm.

Work 2 cm St-st in rnds.

Dec 2 sts on next rnd as follows:

Sl 1 k-wise, k1, psso, work until 2 sts rem,s k2tog.

Rep dec approx every 2% cm until (50) 52 (54) 58 (60) 64 sts rem.

Cont until sleeve meas (21) 24 (26) 28 (31) 36 cm, or (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm before suitable length.

Cast off 6 sts evenly spaced = (44) 46 (48) 52 (54) 58

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

FINISHING

LEFT FRONT BAND FOR GIRL/RIGHT FOR BOY

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row on front edge to approx (101) 111 (123) 135 (145) 145 sts.

Number of sts a multiple of 2+1.

Work 7 rows ribbing as follows:

 $1 \, \text{edge st}$, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-*, end with $1 \, \text{edge st}$. Cast off rib-wise.

RIGHT FRONT BAND FOR GIRL/LEFT FOR BOY

Work in the same manner, but with (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 buttonholes evenly distributed on 4th row. The upper and lower approx 1 cm from each end.

Buttonhole: k2tog, 1 yo.

Cast off rib-wise.

Sew buttons on.
