



#VERAGENSER / NO 4 / INSTRUCTION: LIV STANGELAND KNITTING SKILL LEVEL *** MEDIUM

SIZE

(2-4) 6-8 (10-12) yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (66) 74 (82) cm Length: (40) 48 (52) cm

Sleeve length: (24-27) 30-33 (36-40) cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE SWEATER

Work sweater from hem up.

Beg to work 2 parts for front back and forth. Inc at sides to full width. Join the 2 parts, inc at sides and dec at middle front to create the V-form. Work the back in same manner. Work sleeves in rnds. Assemble and sew tog all parts at finish.

YARN

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

Rose cheek #4012: (3) 4 (4) balls Blue hydrangea #6032: 1 ball each size Rhododendron #4545: 1 ball each size Lt.limestone #2319: (1) 1 (2) balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

INC₁

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch.

STRIPES

Work (3½) 4 (4½) cm St-st with blue hydrangea. Work (3½) 4 (4½) cm St-st with rhododendron.

FRONT

With rose cheek and 3 mm circular ndl cast on 2 sts and work St-st back and forth as follows:

Work 2 rows, at the same time cast on 2 new sts at end of every row = 4 sts inc.

*Work 4 rows, <u>at the same time</u> cast on 1 st at end of every row = 4 sts inc.

Work 2 rows, at the same time cast on 2 new sts at end of every row = 4 sts inc*.

Rep from *-* until (62) 70 (78) sts.

Put aside.

Work one more part in the same manner.

Transfer sts for both parts to the same circular ndl and insert marker at junction.

Cont with rose cheek and St-st over all sts in this manner:

*Work 2 rows, cast on 1 new st at beg and end of every row, and dec 2 middle front sts as follows: k/p2tog before marker, and k/p2tog tbl after marker.

Work 4 rows and at the same time cast on 1 new st at end of every row, and dec 2 middle front sts on every RS row as follows: k2tog before marker, and k2tog tbl after marker*.

Rep from * - * until garment meas approx (26) 32 (34) cm, meas at side.

Work stripe pattern with inc at sides and dec at middle front as usual.

Change to lt.limestone after stripe pattern, and work until garment meas (38) 46 (50) cm, meas at side.

Work St-st and dec at middle front as usual, <u>at the</u> same time cast off for shoulders as follows:

Cast off 1 st at each side on alt rows twice, and 1 st at beg and end of every row twice, rep from *-* until (52) 56 (60) sts rem.

Transfer sts to spare ndl.

THE BACK

Cast on and work in the same manner as front.

SLEEVES

With rose cheek and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (40) 44 (48) sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls.

Work 1 rnd St-st, while inc 6 sts evenly spaced = (46) 50 (54) sts.

Insert marker around first and last st on rnd.

Cont St-st until sleeve meas 5 cm.

Inc 1 st on each side of marker as follows:

Knit 1, inc 1, work until 1 st rem on rnd, inc 1, knit last st

Rep inc every (1½-2) 1½-2 (2-2) cm until (68) 78 (84) sts

Cont until sleeve meas approx (24-27) 30-33 (36-40) cm, or suitable length.

Cast off.

Put aside and work other sleeve in the same manner.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Sew tog sides until approx (13) 15 (16) cm rem for armhole = equivalent width at top of sleeve. Sew sleeves on.

NECKBAND

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 2.5 mm circular ndl = (104) 112 (120) sts.

Work 2 cm ribbing with lt.limestone in rnds k2, p2. Cast off rib-wise.

HEM RIBBING

Fasten all yarn ends.

With rose cheek and 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up (180) 200 (220) sts at lower edge of back/front.

Work 2 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Cast off suitably loose rib-wise.

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
