TOBIAS SWEATER

#TOBIASGENSER / NO 7 / INSTRUCTION: OLAUG BEATE BJELLAND KNITTING SKILL LEVEL ** EASY

SIZE

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (64) 68 (74) 80 (86) 90 cm

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm, or suitable length

Sleeve length: (24) 28 (31) 34 (37) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE SWEATER

Work sweater with stripe pattern in rnds from hem to underarms. Divide work at sides and work back and front separately from here.

Work sleeves from top down. Start to work turning rows to create and shape a nice sleeve cap, cont with stripe pattern in the same manner as back/front. Work neckband.

YARN

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

Moss green #9573: (3) 3 (3) 4 (5) 6 balls Dusty lt.green #9041: (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) 3 balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

INC₁

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch

GSR = GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always sl first st p-wise with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl. The 2 loops count as 1 st. When working rows/rnds with loops work loops tog to 1 st.

Edge st: k every row

BACK AND FRONT

With moss green and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (172) 184 (200) 216 (232) 244 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Insert marker at sides with (86) 92 (100) 108 (116) 122 sts for each part.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Cont St-st until work meas (5) 6 (7) 8 (8½) 9 cm.

Cont stripe pattern as follows:

Change to dusty lt.green, work diagram, change to moss green and work (5) 6 (7) 8 (8½) 9 cm St-st, rep from * -*, at the same time when work meas (23) 26 (28) 30 (30) 30 cm, cast off (6) 8 (10) 10 (12) 14 sts at each side for armholes (= (3) 4 (5) 5 (6) 7 sts on each side of markers).

Cont each part back and forth.

THE BACK

= (80) 84 (90) 98 (104) 108 sts.

Work <u>stripe pattern</u> back and forth, <u>and at the same time</u> cast off for armholes at beg of every row 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st 3 times = 8 sts cast off at each side and (64) 68 (74) 82 (88) 92 sts rem.

Cont with 1 edge st at each side. When diagram is worked a total of 3 times, garment will meas approx (30) 33 (36) 39 (40%) 42 cm.

Cont with moss green until armhole meas (11) 12 (13) 14(16) 17 cm.

Cast off for slanting shoulders at beg of every row 5 sts (0)1(0)2(0)2 times, 4 sts (4)3(4)3(6)4 times, 3 sts (0)0(1)0(0)0 time = (16) 17 (19) 22 (24) 26 sts cast off on each side.

Transfer rem (32) 34 (36) 38 (40) 40 sts to spare ndl for neckband.

FRONT

= (80) 84 (90) 98 (104) 108 sts.

Work and cast off for armhole on each side in the same manner as the back, and cont until armhole meas (8) 9 (10) 11 (13) 14 cm.

Cast off the (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) 26 middle front sts for neck and work each side separately.

RIGHT SIDE FRONT

= (23) 24 (26) 29 (31) 33 sts.

Cast off at neck side 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice at beg of every row, and cast off for slanting shoulder at the same length and in the same manner as the back.

LEFT SIDE FRONT

= (23) 24 (26) 29 (31) 33 sts.

Work in the same manner as right side.

Sew shoulder seams inside 1 stitch to a smooth and even seam.

SLEEVES

Beg at middle underarm and with moss green and 3 mm double pointed ndls knit up 1 st in each of the cast off underarm sts, and knit up at armhole edge 1 st every st/row but miss every 4th st/row to (66) 72 (80) 86 (98) 104 sts.

Insert one marker at middle underarm and one at middle shoulder, by shoulder seam.

Work St-st and turning rows with \underline{GSR} to shape a nice sleeve cap as follows:

Work until (8) 8 (8) 10 (12) 14 sts pass shoulder marker, turn. Purl (8) 8 (8) 10 (12) 14 sts pass shoulder marker on other side.

Turn and work in the same manner, but turn 2 sts pass previous turning until a total of (11) 12 (13) 15 (16) 17 turnings on each side.

Work (1) 3 (4) 4 (1) 3 cm in rnds over all sts, at the same time dec 2 sts at middle underarm as follows: Work k2tog tbl, work until 2 sts rem on rnd, k2tog.

Rep dec every (2) 2 (2) 2 (1½) 1½ cm, at the same time work stripe pattern as follows:

Change to dusty lt.green, work <u>diagram</u>, change to moss green and work (5) 6 (7) 8 (8½) 9 cm St-st, rep from *-* until diagram is worked (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) 3 times. Cont with moss green and rep dec in the same manner until (46) 48 (52) 54 (58) 60 sts rem.

Work until sleeve meas (21) 25 (28) 30 (33) 36 cm, or (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm before suitable length, at the same time dec evenly spaced (6) 6 (8) 8 (10) 10 sts on last rnd = (40) 42 (44) 46 (48) 50 sts.

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

NECKBAND


Beg at right side on the back, and with moss green and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls knit up 1 st in every st on neck edge.

Knit 1 rnd, <u>at the same time</u> dec evenly spaced to (104) 108 (112) 116 (120) 124 sts.

Work (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.
