PIXIE HAT

(1) 2 (4) yrs

Yarn:SMART (100 % wool, superwash,
50 g = 100 m)**Alternative yarn:**PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO,
MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULLNote: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to
check the yardage on label. The image of
garment might change by using alternative yarn**Yarn required:**Rhododendron #4544/Dk.blue #6062:
(2) 3 (3) balls**Suggested knitting needles:**

Circular 3 mm and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your
knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker
needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.**Tension:**22 sts pattern with 3.5 mm ndls = 10
cm**Edge st: k every row****Front:**With 3.5 mm ndl cast on (44) 48 (52)
sts.Work ribbing back and forth as
follows:**(1) and (4) yrs:**1 edge st, k2, *p2, k2*, rep from *-*,
end with 1 edge st (1st row = WS).**2 yrs:**1 edge st, p2, *k2, p2 *, rep from *-*,
end with 1 edge st (1st row = WS).**All sizes:**Insert marker at center front with (22)
24 (26) sts for each side (= insert
marker between 2 p sts on RS).Work in this order until hat meas (12)
13 (14) cm, last row = WS.

Put front aside and work back..

Back:

Cast on and work as front.

Back and front:Transfer sts for back and front to the
same 3 mm ndl = (88) 96 (104) sts,
and work (4) 5 (6) cm ribbing in rnds.Divide work at center front marker and
cont back and forth on 3.5 mm ndl as
follows:**Row 1:** (= RS) Sl first st off ndl, pull
yarn firmly and work k2, p2, *k2, p2*,
rep from *-*, end with k3.**Row 2:** (= WS) Sl first st off ndl, pull
yarn firmly and work k on k sts, p on p
sts.**Row 3:** Work as row 1.**Row 4:** Sl first st off ndl, pull yarn
firmly and k4, p2, *k2, p2 *, rep from *-
*, end with k5.**Row 5:** Work as row 2.**Row 6:** Work as row 4.Cont in this manner and work 2 more
k/p sts at beg and end of every 3rd
row until no more ribbing sts rem.Transfer half number of sts on ndl to a
spare ndl.With RS facing from both parts k1 st
tog from each ndl, **at the same time**
cast off loosely.
