



RAGLAN SWEATER W/CABLE / INSTRUCTION: ASA CHRISTIANSEN

SIZES

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (66) 70 (74) 78 (82) 88 cm Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 54 cm Sleeve length: (23) 26 (29) 32 (35) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

YARN

SMART (100 % wool, Superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MERINOULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

YARN REQUIRED

Natural melange #2641: (4) 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3.5 mm and 4 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

20 sts St-st with 4 mm ndls = 10 cm

EDGE ST: K EVERY ROW

BACK AND FRONT

With 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on (146) 154 (162) 172 (180) 194 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

 $K 1 \, \text{rnd} \, \underline{\text{while}} \, \text{dec} \, (14) \, 14 \, (14) \, 16 \, (16) \, 18 \, \text{sts} \, \text{evenly} \\ \text{spaced} \, = \, (132) \, 140 \, (148) \, 156 \, (164) \, 176 \, \text{sts}. \\ \text{Insert marker at sides with} \, (66) \, 70 \, (74) \, 78 \\ (82) \, 88 \, \text{sts} \, \text{for each part, and insert marker} \\ \text{around the} \, 10 \, \text{middle} \, \text{front} \, \text{sts}. \\ \end{cases}$

Change to 4 mm circular ndl, cont St-st and with <u>diagram</u> over the 10 middle front sts (= 13 sts after first round). Cont until garment meas approx (25) 27 (30) 33 (35) 36 cm.

Cast off (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 sts at each side for armholes (= (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 sts at each side of side marks).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

SLEEVES

With 3.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (30) 32 (34) 36 (38) 40 sts. Join and work 5 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

K 1 rnd while inc (10) 12 (14) 16 (18) 20 sts evenly spaced = (40) 44 (48) 52 (56) 60 sts. Insert marker between first and last st on rnd. Insert marker around the 10 middle sts on rnd. Change to 4 mm double pointed ndls and cont St-st and diagram over 10 middle sts (= 13 sts after first rnd).

Cont until sleeve meas approx (23) 26 (29) 32 (35) 40 cm, and end with the same pattern rnd as back/front.

Cast off (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 underarm sts (= (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 sts at each side of marker).
Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

RAGLAN

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 4 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (197) 213 (229) 237 (253) 273 sts on rnd.

Insert marker at each junction.

Cont St-st and <u>diagram</u>, <u>and at the same</u> <u>time</u> dec for raglan as follows: k2tog after each marker, and k2tog tbl before each marker = 8 sts dec.

Rep raglan dec on alt rnds a total of (8) 10 (12) 13 (15) 17 times = (133) 133 (133) 133 (133) 137 sts.

Transfer the (13) 13 (13) 15 (15) 17 middle front sts for neck to spare ndl, at the same time k2tog over cables as shown on last rnd in diagram (= (10) 10 (10) 12 (12) 14 sts at neck). Cont to end of rnd, cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Dec for raglan on RS rows.

Cont back and forth and dec for raglan as before, and cast off for neck at beg of every row 2 sts (2)2(2)1(1)1 times, and 1 st (0)0(0)1(1)1 time, at the same time cont raglan dec twice more.

Divide work at all 4 raglan dec and work each part separately.

LEFT FRONT

Cont St-st back and forth, at the same time shape shoulder by cast off at beg of every row from sleeve side 2 sts once, 3 sts 3 times (all sizes).

RIGHT FRONT

Work in the same manner as left front but in a mirror image.

BACK

Cont St-st back and forth, at the same time shape shoulder at each side as fronts = (18) 18 (18) 18 (18) 20 sts rem.

Transfer neck sts to spare ndl.

SHOULDER PIECE

Cont back and forth, with 1 edge st at each side until shoulder piece meas approx 5½ cm (the same length as the slanting shoulder edge at back and front).

Cast off, at the same time k2tog 3 times over cable as at front.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder piece to back and front. Sew underarm openings.

NECKBAND

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 3.5 mm circular ndl and at the same time knit up sts at neck edge to approx (66) 68 (72) 76 (80) 82 sts. Number of sts a multiple of med 2. Work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds, Cast off loosely rib-wise.
