



NO 1 SKIPPER'S ARAN SWEATER

Sweater w/cables and saddle shoulders
Instruction: Anita Brathetland

Shoulders:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: approx (63) 69 (72) 75 (81)
87 cm

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm
Sleeve length: (24) 28 (31) 34 (37) 40 cm,
or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment
= personal body measurements + movement
allowance. The measurements are all according to
given tension.

Yarn:

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g =
175 m)

Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT,
ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL,
BABYULL LANETT

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check
the yardage on label. The image of garment might
change by using alternative yarn.

Yarn required:

Lt.limestone #2319: (4) 5 (6) 7 (9) 10 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and
3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting
shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser
tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

27 sts double moss st pattern with 3 mm
ndls = 10 cm

Diagram A meas approx 23 cm

Diagram B meas approx 8 cm

Double moss st pattern:

Rnd 1: Work *k1, p1*, rep from *-*.

Rnd 2: Work sts as they appear

Rnd 3: Work *p1, k1*, rep from *-*.

Rnd 4: Work sts as they appear

Back and front:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (216)
232 (240) 248 (264) 280 sts. Join and
work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing in rnds as
follows:

Sizes (2) 4 8 (10) 12 yrs:

Work k1, p2, *k2, p2*, rep from *-* in the
rnd, end with k1.

Sizes (6) yrs:

Work p1, k2, *p2, k2*, rep from *-* end
with p1.

All sizes:

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

*Work (11) 15 (17) 19 (23) 27 sts **double
moss st pattern**, work diagram **A** and inc
as shown in diagram, work (11) 15 (17) 19
(23) 27 sts **double moss st pattern**, inc 1
st (= pick up yarn between 2 sts and p tbl
this new st)*, rep from *-* once more =
(246) 262 (270) 278 (294) 310 sts.

Insert marker around the middle st at
each section of moss st pattern with (122)
130 (134) 138 (146) 154 sts for each part
Cont in this order until garment meas
approx (22) 25 (28) 31 (32) 33 cm.

Cast off 9 sts at each side for armholes (=
marked st + 4 sts at each side of markers).
Work each part separately.

NOTE: Work twisting of cables on RS-rows.

Edge st: k every row

Back:

= (114) 122 (126) 130 (138) 146 sts.

Cont back and forth in the same order,
inside 1 edge st at each side and cast
off for armhole at beg of every row at
each side 3 sts (0)1(1)1(1)3 times, 2 sts
(1)2(2)2(3)3 times, 1 st (4)3(3)3(3)1 times,
= (102) 102 (106) 110 (114) 114 sts.

Cont until armhole meas (8) 9 (10) 11 (12)
13 cm.

Shape and cast off for shoulders at beg of
every row at each side 8 sts once, 7 sts 3
times.

Note: Work last row of diagram **A**, at the
same time work dec over cables, and
k2tog count as 1 st at shoulder cast-off.

Work last row of diagram **A** over rem sts
and transfer these middle sts to spare ndl
for neck = (30) 30 (34) 38 (42) 42 sts.

NOTE: Adjust dec over the large middle
back cable to match k2, p2 ribbing for
neckband.

Front:

= (114) 122 (126) 130 (138) 146 sts.

Work and cast off for armholes in the
same manner as the back = (102) 102
(106) 110 (114) 114 sts.

Cont until armhole meas (8) 9 (10) 11 (12)

13 cm.

Shape and cast off shoulder sts from
armhole side as the back and transfer the
(28) 28 (30) 32 (34) 34 middle front sts to
spare ndl for neck.

NOTE: Dec 6 sts over the large, middle
front cable **while** transferring sts to spare
ndl for neck, and adjust dec to match k2,
p2 ribbing for neckband = (22) 22 (24) 26
(28) 28 sts on spare ndl.

Work each side separately, shape and cast
off for shoulders and cast off for neck at
beg of every row 3 sts (0)0(0)0(1)1 time,
2 sts (1)1(2)3(2)2 times, 1 st (2)2(1)0(0)0
times.

NOTE: Work last row of diagram **A** at the
same time as dec over cables, k2tog count
as 1 st at cast off for shoulder/neck.

Work other side the same but in a mirror
image.

Sleeves:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast
on (40) 44 (44) 48 (48) 52 sts. Join and
work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing in rnds as
follows:

Size (2) 8 (10) yrs:

p1, k2, *p2, k2*, rep from *-* end with
p1.

Size 4 (6) 12 yrs:

k1, p2, *k2, p2*, rep from *-* end with k1.

All sizes:

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls
Work (5) 7 (7) 9 (9) 11 sts **double moss st
pattern**, diagram **B**, (5) 7 (7) 9 (9) 11 sts
double moss st pattern, inc 1 (= pick up
yarn between 2 sts and p tbl this new st)
= (45) 49 (49) 53 (53) 57 sts.

Insert marker around the middle st at
double moss st section.

Cont in this order until sleeve meas 6 cm.
Inc 1 st at each side of diagram **B** (= pick
up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl/p this
new st).

Work new sts in **double moss st pattern**
as they arise.

Rep inc approx every (1) 1½ (1½) 1½ (1½)
1½ cm until (73) 77 (81) 85 (89) 93 sts.

Cont until sleeve meas (24) 28 (31) 34 (37)
40 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 9 middle underarm sts (= marked
st + 4 sts at each side).

Cont back and forth and cast off at beg of
every row at each side 3 sts (2)2(3)3(4)5
times, 2 sts (2)3(3)4(3)3 times, 1 st
(4)4(3)3(4)3 times = 36 sts.

NOTE: Work twisting of cables on RS-rows.
Sleeve cap will now fit into armhole on
back/front.

Cont diagram **B** for saddle shoulder, inside

1 edge st at each side.

Cont until saddel shoulder (slightly stretched) meas approx the same as shaped shoulder at back and front.

Leave sts on spare ndl.

Work other sleeve the same.

Finishing:

Sew sleeve to back and front.

Neckband:

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 2.5 mm circular ndl, at the same time knit up sts at neck edge, and work last row of diagram **B** over sleeve sts.







Work 1 row with sts as they appear, and at the same time adjust number of sts to (104) 108 (112) 116 (120) 124.

Adjust sts for ribbing to match nicely to pattern.

Work 6 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

- k on RS, p on WS
- p on RS, k on WS
- Inc 1 st: pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st
-  Transfer 2 sts to extra ndl and hold in back of work, k1, k sts from extra ndl
-  Transfer 1 st to extra ndl and hold in front of work, k2, k st from extra ndl
-  Transfer 4 sts to extra ndl and hold in front of work, k4, k sts from extra ndl
-  Transfer 4 sts to extra ndl and hold in back of work, k4, k sts from extra ndl
-  Transfer 4 sts to extra ndl and hold in front of work, p1, k sts ndl from extra ndl
-  Transfer 1 st to extra ndl and hold in back of work, k4, k st from extra ndl
- k2tog
