HARALD CARDIGAN

Cardigan

Instruction: Sandnes garn

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: approx (67) 71 (75) 78 (86) 89 cm

Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 52 cm

Sleeve length: (25) 29 (32) 35 (38) 40 cm

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

SMART (100 % wool, superwash, 50 g = 100 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, ALPAKKA, DUO, MANDARIN MEDI, MERINOULL, SPØT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternate yarn.

Yarn required:

Corn yellow #2015: (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 balls

Putty #1015: (2) 2 (2) 2 (3) 3 balls

Notions:

(5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 buttons

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

Buttonhole: 1 yo, k2tog.

Back and front:

With corn yellow and 3 mm circular ndl cast on (157) 165 (173) 181 (197) 205 sts and work (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

(1st row = WS) 1 edge st, p1, *k1, p1*, rep from *-, end with 1 edge st,

and at the same time after 2 cm work 1 buttonhole inside 3 sts from left front edge for girl/from right front edge for boy.

Transfer the first 7 sts and last 7 sts to holders [for front bands. These are worked later] = (143) 151 (159) 167 (183) 191 sts on ndl. Change to 3.5 mm circ ndl. Cast on 5 new sts at end of row [= cutting sts. These sts are not included in diagram or given number of sts].

Insert marker on 1 st at each side with (34) 36 (38) 40 (44) 46 sts for each front and (73) 77 (81) 85 (93) 97 sts for the back.

Join and work 1 rnd St-st.

Cont with diagram A until work meas (22) 26 (30) 34 (38) 38 cm. Work diagram B, then diagram C, and at the same time at arrow marked in diagram, transfer the (13) 13 (15) 15 (17) 17 middle front sts [cutting sts included] to a holder.

Cont diagram back and forth and cast off at neck at beg of every row at each side 3 sts once, 2 sts twice, 1 st twice. Cont in corn yellow until work meas (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 52 cm. Cast off.

Sleeves:

With corn yellow and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (36) 36 (40) 40 (40) 44 sts. Join and work (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Insert marker on first and last st on rnd.


Change to 3.5 mm double pointed ndls and work 1 rnd St-st. Cont with diagram A until sleeve meas approx (5) 5 (6) 6 (6) 6 cm. Inc 1 st at each side of marker. Rep inc every 2 cm until (52) 56 (60) 64 (68) 70 sts on rnd, and at the same time when sleeve meas (19) 23 (26) 29 (32) 34 cm work diagram B. Cont until sleeve meas (25) 29 (32) 35 (38) 40 cm, or suitable length.

Turn sleeve inside out and work 6 rows St-st back and forth [for facing] with opening at center underarm. Cast off. Work other sleeve the same

Finishing:

Measure top of sleeve and insert marker at each side for depth of armholes. With machine sew 2 seams at each side on center front cutting sts and at each side of armhole openings. Cut between seams. Zigzag cut edges.

TIPS: Work front bands and facings before cutting at center front.



Sew shoulder seams.

Sew on sleeves. Fold facings over cut edge and sew with invisible sts.

Left front band girl/Right front band boy:

Transfer sts from holder to 3 mm circ ndl and at the same time cast on 4 new sts for facing at garment side. Work these 4 sts in reverse St-st [= p on RS, k on WS and cont ribbing over sts for band.

With corn yellow work until band and facing measure the same as front edge with band/facing slightly stretched.

Cast off sts for facing and transfer the 7 sts for band to a spare ndl.

Right front band girl/Left front band boy:

Work in the same manner but with (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 buttonholes evenly spaced.

The upper at center of neckband. This is done later.

Sew front band to edge. On WS fold facing over cut edge and sew with invisible sts.

Neckband:

With corn yellow and 3 mm circ ndl transfer sts from spare ndls and pick up and knit 1 st every st/row but skip every 4th st/row at neck edge until approx (97) 99 (103) 107 (111) 111 sts. Number of sts a multiple of 2+1. Work 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 back and forth. Remember last buttonhole. Cast off rib-wise. Sew buttons on
