DRESS

Dress in St-st Instruction: Asa Christiansen

Sizes:

(XS) S (M) L (XL) XXL

Measurements:

Bust: (82) 86 (96) 102 (109) 119 cm Hem width: (87) 90 (100) 107 (113)

Length: approx (86) 88 (90) 92 (94) 94 cm

Sleeve length: 47 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

ALPAKKA SILKE (70 % baby alpaca, 30 % mulberry silk, 50 g = 200 m) TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

Yarn required:

ALPAKKA SILKE

Dusty green #7741: (5) 6 (6) 7 (7) 8

TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Dusty petrol melange #7210: (4) 5 (5) 6 (6) 7 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed ndls 4 mm and 5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

18 sts St-st with 5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Work dress and cowl with double yarn:

1 strand ALPAKKA SILKE + 1 strand TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Back and front:

With double yarn and 4 mm circular ndl cast on (156) 162 (180) 192 (204) 222 sts. Join and work 3 cm ribbing k3, p3 in rnds. Change to 5 mm circular ndl and cont in St-st.

Insert marker at sides with (78) 81 (90) 96 (102) 111 sts between markers.

Cont until work meas (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 29 cm. Dec at side markers as

follows: Before marker: k2tog. After marker: k2tog tbl = 4 sts dec.

Rep dec after 25 cm = (148) 154 (172) 184 (196) 214 sts.

Cont until work meas (68) 69 (70) 71 (72) 71 cm.

Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers).

Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With double yarn and 4 mm double pointed ndls cast on 36 sts [for all sizes]. Join and work 5 cm ribbing k3, p3 in rnds.

Change to 5 mm double pointed ndls and cont in St-st while **inc** (4) 6 (8) 8 (10) 10 sts evenly spaced on first rnd = (40) 42 (44) 44 (46) 46 sts.

Insert marker on first and last st of rnd.

When work meas 7 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker, and cont inc every (5) 5 (5) 4 (4) 4 cm until (56) 58 (60) 62 (64) 66 sts.

Cont until sleeve meas 47 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 center underarm sts (= marked sts + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 5 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (228) 238 (260) 276 (292) 314 sts.

Insert marker at each junction.

Work 1 rnd St-st, then dec for raglan at each marker as follows: After marker: k2tog. Before marker: k2tog tbl = 8 sts dec.

Rep raglan dec on alt rnds (10) 11 (11) 12 (12) 13 times = (148) 150 (172) 180 (196) 210 sts.

Cont dec on alt rnds **but** on sleeve sts only [work sts for back and front without dec] (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) 8 times = (124) 126 (144) 152 (164) 178 sts.

Transfer the (10) 11 (12) 14 (16) 17 center front sts to a spare ndl for neck, and cont back and forth in rows. Cont raglan dec on sleeves 6 times more, at the same time cast off 2 sts at beg of every row for neck.

Leave sts on ndl for neck.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Neckband:

Transfer sts from ndl to small 4 mm circular ndl and with double yarn knit up sts at neck to approx (114) 114 (120) 120 (126) 126 sts on ndl. Number of sts a multiple of 6. Work 3 cm ribbing k3, p3 in rnds. Cast off.

Cowl in ribbing Instrution: Åsa Christiansen

Size:

One size

Yarn required:

ALPAKKA SILKE
Dusty green #7741: 1 ball
TYNN SILK MOHAIR
Dusty petrol melange #7210: 1 ball

With double yarn and 5 mm circular ndl cast on 96 sts. Join and work ribbing k3, p3 in rnds until cowl meas approx 22 cm.

Cast off rib-wise.
