SIZES

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (56) 59 (64) 70 (73) 80 cm

Hips: (68) 75 (80) 88 (94) 100 cm

Length: (68) 74 (81) 91 (98) 106 cm

Leg length: (24) 27 (31) 37 (40) 44 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 220 m)

YARN REQUIRED

Terracotta #4234: (3) 4 (4) 5 (6) 7 balls

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3 mm

Crochet hook 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

RIDGE WORKED BACK AND FORTH

k 2 rows = 1 ridge

EDGE ST: K EVERY ROW

Beg at ankle of one leg.

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (182) 186 (192) 198 (202) 208 sts, and work 3 ridges back and forth.

Cast off 65 sts at each side for bands (tie-bands at ankle) = (52) 56 (62) 68 (72) 78 sts. Work 1 row St-st, while inc evenly spaced to (93) 101 (109) 121 (127) 137 sts.

Cont St-st back and forth (3) 3 (4) 4 (5) 5 cm, at the same time sl first st k/p-wise every row. Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls and k tog first and last st on rnd = (92) 100 (108) 120 (126) 136 sts.

Cont St-st in rnds until leg meas (24) 27 (31) 37 (40) 44 cm, or suitable length.

Work other leg in the same manner.

Transfer sts for both legs to the same 3 mm circular ndl, with the slit at opposite sides (outside of legs), at the same time insert marker at each side with (92) 100 (108) 120 (126) 136 sts for each part.

Cont St-st in rnds and dec 1 st at each side of side markers = 4 sts dec.

Rep dec every (3½) 3 (3) 2½ (2½) 3 cm (7) 9 (10) 12 (13) 13 times more = (152) 160 (172) 188 (196) 216 sts.

Cont until garment meas (56) 61 (67) 76 (82) 89 cm.

Divide for armhole at each marker, and work each side separately.

FRONT

= (76) 80 (86) 94 (98) 108 sts.

Cont St-st back and forth and cast off for armholes at beg of every row 3 sts twice, 2 sts

once at each side = (60) 64 (70) 78 (82) 92 sts. Dec further inside 1 edge st at each side as follows:

1 edge st, k2tog tbl, work until 3 sts rem, k2tog, 1 edge st.

Rep dec on alt rows (9) 9 (8) 9 (10) 13 times more = (40) 44 (52) 58 (60) 64 sts.

Cont until work meas (64) 70 (76) 86 (92) 100 cm.

Cast off the (6) 6 (14) 16 (18) 22 middle sts for neck and work each side separately = (17) 19 (19) 21 (21) 21 sts at each side.

Cast off at neck on alt rows 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, 1 st twice = (6) 8 (8) 10 (10) 10 sts.

Cont until work meas (68) 74 (81) 91 (98) 106 cm.

Cont St-st back and forth (20) 21 (22) 24 (26) 28 cm for tie-bands.

Cast off.

BACK

Work in the same manner as front.

FINISHING

With 3 mm crochet hook work crab sts at edges for neck, armholes and tie-bands.

CRAB STS

Works sc from left to right.
