DRESS W/PLEAT AT BACK / INSTRUCTION: ANETTE HELLSTRØM OLSEN

SIZES

(1) 2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (53) 56 (61) 64 (68) 73 (79) cm
Hem width: (74) 80 (86) 92 (98) 102 (110) cm
Length: (41) 44 (49) 55 (61) 67 (72) cm
All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 220 m)

YARN REQUIRED

Dusty lilac #4621: (2) 3 (4) 5 (6) 7 (8) balls

NOTIONS

1 button

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 3 mm
Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

RIDGE WORKED IN ROUNDS

p 1 rnd, k 1 rnd = 1 ridge

RIDGE WORKED BACK AND FORTH

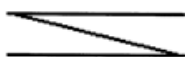
k 2 rows = 1 ridge

PLEAT A (= (18) 18 (18) 24 (24) 24 (30)

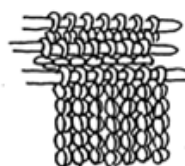
STS): Transfer the first (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 (10) sts to first extra ndl, transfer the next (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 (10) sts to second extra ndl. Place these 2 extra ndls together with left hand's ndl in front.

Work 1 st from each of the 3 ndls tog. Rep from *-* a total of (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 (10) times = (12) 12 (12) 16 (16) 16 (20) sts dec.

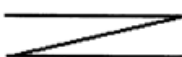

PLEAT B (= (18) 18 (18) 24 (24) 24 (30)

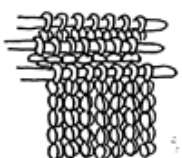
STS): Transfer the next (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 (10) sts to the first extra ndl, transfer the next (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 (10) sts to the second extra ndl. Place these 2 extra ndls with left hand's ndl in back.

Work 1 st from each of the 3 ndls together. Rep from *-* a total of (6) 6 (6) 8 (8) 8 (10) times = (12) 12 (12) 16 (16) 16 (20) sts dec.

BACK AND FRONT

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (200) 216 (232) 248 (264) 276 (296) sts. Join and work 2 ridges in rnds.

Insert marker at sides with (88) 96 (104) 108 (116) 122 (128) sts for front and (112) 120 (128) 140 (148) 154 (168) sts for the back.

Cont St-st and dec 2 sts at each side as follows: k2tog tbl before each marker and k2tog after each marker = 4 sts dec.

Rep dec every (3½) 3 (3) 3½ (3½) 4 (5) cm (7) 9 (10) 10 (11) 11 (10) times more = (168) 176 (188) 204 (216) 228 (252) sts.

Cont until garment meas (30) 32 (36) 41 (46) 51 (56) cm.

Work pleats over sts for the back in this manner:

Work (30) 32 (35) 35 (38) 41 (43) sts, work pleat B, pleat A, work (30) 32 (35) 35 (38) 41 (43) sts (= the back), cont St-st to end of rnd = (144) 152 (164) 172 (184) 196 (212) sts on ndl.

Cast off (8) 8 (10) 10 (10) 12 (12) sts at each side for armholes (= (4) 4 (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) sts at each side of markers), and work each part separately.

BACK

= (64) 68 (72) 76 (82) 86 (94) sts.

Cont St-st and cast off for armhole at beg of every row 2 sts (1)1(1)1(1)2 times, 1 st (1)2(1)1(1)2(2) times = (58) 60 (66) 70 (76) 78 (82) sts.

Cont until garment meas (38) 41 (46) 51 (57) 63 (69) cm.

Divide work at middle back for slit, and work

each side separately = (29) 30 (33) 35 (38) 39 (41) sts for each part.

Left side:

(First row = WS.)

Work 1 row and cast on 6 sts (for placket) at end of row at middle back = (35) 36 (39) 41 (44) 45 (47) sts.

Cont St-st back and forth until garment meas (40) 43 (48) 54 (60) 66 (71) cm, at the same time sl first st every RS row further.

Cast off for neck first (16) 17 (18) 18 (19) 18 (18) sts, then 3 sts once for all sizes = (16) 16 (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) shoulder sts rem, and transfer these sts to spare ndl.

Right side:

(First row = WS.)

Cont St-st back and forth until garment meas (40) 43 (48) 54 (60) 66 (71) cm, at the same time sl first st every WS row further.

Cast off at neck first (10) 11 (12) 12 (13) 12 (12) sts, then 3 sts once for all sizes = (16) 16 (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) shoulder sts rem, and transfer these sts to spare ndl.

FRONT

= (64) 68 (72) 76 (82) 86 (94) sts.

Cast off for armholes in the same manner as back = (58) 60 (66) 70 (76) 78 (82) sts.

Cont until garment meas (37) 40 (45) 50 (56) 61 (67) cm.

Cast off the 4 middle front sts for v-neck and work each side separately = (27) 28 (31) 33 (36) 37 (39) sts for each side

Right side:

(First row = WS.)

Cont St-st back and forth, at the same time cast off at neck at beg of every RS-row 2 sts (4)5(6)4(5)3(3) times, 1 st (3)2(1)5(4)7(7) times.

Transfer rem (16) 16 (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) shoulder sts to spare ndl.

Left side:

Work in the same manner as right side but in a mirror image.

SLEEVES

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (50) 54 (58) 62 (66) 70 (72) sts. Join and work 2 ridges in rnds.

Insert marker between first and last st on rnd. Cast off (8) 8 (10) 10 (10) 12 (12) middle underarm sts (= (4) 4 (5) 5 (5) 6 (6) sts at each side of marker).

Cont St-st back and forth, at the same time cast off 2 sts at beg of every row (5) 4 (4) 5 (6) 4 (4) times at each side, then 1 st at beg of every row (5) 7 (7) 7 (6) 9 (9) times at each side = (12) 16 (18) 18 (20) 24 (26) sts.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Graft shoulder sts tog.

Sew sleeves on.

Sew the placket (= 6 new sts) for slit to WS on right side of the back.

NECKBAND

With 3 mm circular ntl knit up approx 1 st in each st/row, but miss every 4th st/row at neck edge to approx (68) 72 (76) 80 (84) 86 (88) sts.

Work 3 ridges back and forth, at the same time work 1 buttonhole on 3rd row (2nd ridge) inside 2 sts on right side of the back (because no new sts were cast on at slit).

Buttonhole: k2tog, 1 yo.

Cast off.

Sew button on.
