# MOSS CARDIGAN

Cardigan w/round yoke worked from neck down

Instruction: Liv Stangeland

#### Sizes:

(0-3) 6 (9) mos 1 (2) 3-4 yrs

#### Measurements:

Chest width: (48) 51 (55) 61 (65) 68 cm

Length: approx (24) 26 (28) 32 (36) 40 cm

Sleeve length: (13) 15 (18) 21 (26) 30 cm. or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

#### Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

#### Yarn required:

Dusty pastel green #8521: (2) 2 (3) 3 (4) 4 balls

#### **Notions:**

(5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 buttons

#### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm 27 sts and 40 rows pattern with 2.5 mm ndls = 10x10 cm

#### Rib stitch (rib-st):

k1 in st on previous row

#### Pattern worked in rows:

Row 1: p2, \*1 rib-st, p2\*, rep from \*-\* to end of row.

**Row 2:** k2, \*p1, k2\*, rep from \*-\* to end of row.

#### Inc 1 k st:

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st.

Edge st: k every row

## Begin at neck and work cardigan from neck down

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on a little loosely (65) 71 (77) 85 (91) 95 sts, and work 8 rows ribbing back and forth as follows: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, k1, \*p1, k1\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st.

Work last row from RS.

Next row (= WS) inc as follows: Work 1 edge st, k1, inc 1 k st, \*p1, k1, inc 1 k st\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st = (97) 106 (115) 127 (136) 142 sts.

Cont **pattern** until work meas (4) 4 (5) 5 (5) 5 cm. Last row = RS.

From WS inc as follows: 1 edge st, inc 1 k st, k2 \*p1, inc 1 k st, k2\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st = (129) 141 (153) 169 (181) 189 sts.

Cont **pattern**, but with [p3, 1 rib-st] until work meas (6) 7 (8) 8 (8) 8 cm. Last row = RS.

From WS inc as follows: Work 1 edge st, k3, inc 1 k st, \*p1, k3, inc 1 k st\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st = (161) 176 (191) 211 (226) 236 sts.

Cont **pattern**, but with [p4, 1 rib-st] until work meas (8) 9 (10) 11 (11) 11 cm. Last row = RS.

From WS inc as follows: Work 1 edge st, inc 1 k st, k4, \*p1, inc 1 k st, k4\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st = (193) 211 (229) 253 (271) 283 sts.

Cont **pattern**, but work [p5, 1 rib-st] until garment meas (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 cm.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl. Cont St-st and divide sts for sleeves, back and front in this manner: Work 1 edge st, work (27) 30 (32) 36 (38) 40 sts (= front), transfer (40) 44 (48) 52 (56) 58 sts to spare ndl for sleeves, cast on 6 new underarm sts, work (57) 61 (67) 75 (81) 85 sts (= back), transfer (40) 44 (48) 52 (56) 58 sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on 6 new underarm sts, work (27) 30 (32) 36 (38) 40 sts (= front, 1 edge st.

#### **Back and front:**

= (125) 135 (145) 161 (171) 179 sts. Cont St-st back and forth inside 1 edge st at each side. Cont until garment meas approx (22) 24 (25) 29 (33) 37 cm, or (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 cm before suitable length.

Change to 2.5 mm circular ndl and work (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 back and forth.

Cast off rib-wise.

#### Sleeves:

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 3 mm double pointed ndls, and at the same time knit up 6 sts over the new underarm sts = (46) 50 (54) 58 (62) 64 sts.

Insert marker around 2 middle underarm sts.

Cont 2 cm St-st in rnds, and dec 1 st at each side of marker as follows: k2tog after marker, and k2tog tbl before marker.

Rep dec approx every (2) 2 (2) 2 (2½) 3 cm a total of (5) 6 (7) 8 (8) 8 times = (36) 38 (40) 42 (46) 48 sts.

Cont until sleeve meas (11) 13 (15) 18 (23) 27 cm, or (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 cm before suitable length.

Dec 4 sts evenly spaced = (32) 34 (36) 38 (42) 44 sts.

Work (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off rib-wise.

Work the other sleeve in the same manner.

#### Finishing:

#### Left front band girl/ right boy:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row, but miss every 4th st/row at front edge to approx (67) 73 (79) 89 (101) 111 sts.

Work 7 rows ribbing k1, p1. Cast off rib-wise.

#### Right front band girl/ left boy:

Work in the same manner but with (5) 5 (6) 6 (7) 7 buttonholes evenly spaced on 4<sup>th</sup> row. The upper and lower approx 1 cm from each end of band

Buttonhole: k2tog, 1 yo. Cast off rib-wise Sew buttons on.

### MOSS BONNET

Bonnet w/circle dec at back Instruction: Liv Stangeland

#### Sizes:

(0-3) 6 (9) mos 1 (2) yrs

#### Yarn:

TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

#### Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

#### Yarn required:

Dk.curry #2336: 1 ball all sizes

#### Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm 27 sts and 40 rows pattern with 2.5 mm ndls = 10x10 cm

#### Rib stitch (rib-st):

k1 in st on previous row

#### Pattern worked in rows:

Row 1: p5, \*1 rib-st, p5\*, rep from \*-\* to end of row.

**Row 2:** k5, \*p1, k5\*, rep from \*-\* to end of row.

Edge st: k every row

#### Begin at face edge

With 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (79) 85 (91) 103 (109) sts, and work 8 rows ribbing back and forth in this manner: (First row = WS) 1 edge st, k1, \*p1, k1\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st. Work last row on RS. Work Row 2 of **pattern** inside 1 edge st at each side.

Cont **pattern** inside 1 edge st at each side until work meas (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) cm.

Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls, join and k tog first and last st on rnd = (78) 84 (90) 102 (108) sts on rnd.

Dec on next rnd as follows: \*k2tog k2\*, rep from \*-\*, end with k(2) 0 (2) 2 (0) = (59) 63 (68) 77 (81) sts on rnd. K 5 rnds with no dec.

Next rnd: \*k1, k2tog\*, rep from \*-\*, end with k(2) 0 (2) 2 (0) = (40) 42 (46) 52 (54) sts on rnd.

K 5 rnds with no dec.

Next rnd: k2tog in the rnd = (20) 21 (23) 26 (27) sts.

K 1 rnd with no dec.

Next rnd: k2tog in the rnd, end with k(0) 1 (1) 0 (1)

= (10) 11 (12) 13 (14) sts.

Cut yarn, pass through sts, gather and fasten well.

#### Neckband:

With 2.5 mm circular ndl knit up approx (73) 77 (81) 85 (89) sts at neck edge and work 4 cm ribbing back and forth as at beg of hat.
Cast off rib-wise. Fold neckband to

WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.

Cord:

With 2.5 mm double pointed ndl cast on 4 sts and work in this manner:

K 1 row, slide sts back to other side of ndl, hold yarn firmly and k the 4 sts. Cont in this manner and knit sts from the same side without turning until cord meas approx. (70) 72 (74) 76 (78) cm. Cast off. Pass cord through neckband.
