COOL HAT

Hat in ribbing Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

Sizes:

(2-6) 8-12 yrs

Measurements:

Suitable for head circumference: (44-48) 52-56 cm Length: (16-18) 19-21 cm, included (5) 7 cm foldover

Yarn:

MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 105 m)

Alternative yarn:

PEER GYNT, SMART, ALPAKKA, DUO

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

Yarn required:

Solid color:

Rust #3345: 2 balls all sizes

Stripe pattern:

Main color:

Burnt tawny #2544: 2 balls all sizes

Stripe color:

Dusty petrol #7741: 1 ball all sizes

Notion:

Emblem

Suggested knitting needles:

Double pointed 3 mm

Small circular 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

Tension:

22 sts ribbing with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm, with work slightly stretched

Stripe pattern:

3 rnds burnt tawny, 3 rnds dusty petrol, 3 rnds burnt tawny, 3 rnds dusty petrol.

Dec to left = after 2 p sts as follows:

Transfer 2 k sts to extra ndl and hold in front of work, transfer the following 2 sts to extra ndl and hold in back of work.

Work the first k st from extra ndl tog with the first k st on left ndl, then work the last k st from extra ndl tog with next st on left ndl, transfer the 2 p sts on extra ndl over to left ndl and p3tog.

Dec to right = before 2 p sts as follows:

Work until 7 sts rem before marker, transfer 1 p st to extra ndl and hold in back of work, transfer the following 2 sts to extra ndl and hold in front of work, transfer p st from extra ndl over to left ndl and p3tog, hold the 2 k sts on extra ndl in back of work, work the first k st from extra ndl tog with the first k st on left ndl, then work the last k st on extra ndl tog with next st on left ndl.

With main col and 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (96) 112 sts. Join and work ribbing in **stripe pattern** or **solid color** k2, p2 in rnds.

Change to main color after last stripe and work ribbing until hat meas (5) 7 cm

Change to small 3.5 mm circular ndl. Turn hat inside out, and cont working p on k sts and k on p sts and rnd beg with 2 p sts.

Cont in this manner until hat meas (17-19) 21-23 cm from cast on rnd.

Insert markers for dec as follows:

Place marker with yarn in contrast color around the first 2 sts on rnd (= middle back), and one marker in the same color around 2 p sts at middle front = (46) 54 sts between markers.

With another yarn color insert marker around 2 p sts at each side = (22) 26 sts between markers.

First dec at middle back and middle front:

<u>Dec to left</u> after each marker and <u>dec</u> <u>to right</u> before each marker = 16 sts dec.

Work 2 rnds over sts as they appear. **Second dec at each side:**

<u>Dec to left</u> after each marker and <u>dec</u> <u>to right</u> before each marker = 16 sts dec.

Work 2 rnds over sts as they appear.

(2-6) yrs:

Repeat first dec.

Work 2 rnds over sts as they appear. Rep second dec = (32) sts.

8-12 yrs:

Repeat first dec.

Work 2 rnds over sts as they appear.

Rep second dec

Work 2 rnds over sts as they appear. Repeat first dec = 32 sts.

All sizes:

Work 1 rnd over sts as they appear. Dec on next rnd as follows: k2tog before each marker and k2tog tbl after each marker = 24 sts.

Cut yarn, pass yarn through sts, gather and fasten well.

Sew emblem on.
